- Apr. 1895 Dance for London Rifle Brigade at Bunhill Row.
565 Persons at 2/- per head.
- Jan. 1896 Cinderella Ball. Violin, Cornet,, Banjo, Piano.
Band to be in scarlet uniforms.
- Sept. 1896 Ball. Cornet, Violin, Harp. 16/6 each. 7 p.m. to 4 a.m.
- Dec. 1896 Conversazione at Cripplegete Institute for 770 persons.
- Jan. 1892 Bohemian Concert for Haberdashers Old Boys Club.
- Jan. 1897 Lady Pianist. 6/-.
- Jun. 1897 Queen Victoria's Diamond Jubilee. Ball.
2 Cornets, Flute/Piccolo, Clarionette, Euphonium,
and Trombone. All for £5-10-0.
- Oct. 1897 Harp, Violin, and Bass.
- Jan. 1898 Piano, Violin, Cornet, Clarionette.
- Mar. 1898 Piano, Violin, Cornet, Cello, Double Bass, Piccolo. 10/6 each.
- May 1899 5 Musicians ordered. Client requests "Cornet must not
play too loud".
- Jan. 1900 Dance. Client asks for "Geisha, Belle of New York, & Lancers".
- Jan. 1900 Ball. Band of 7 at 16/6 each. Candles wanted for
Mirrors and Candelabra.
- Feb. 1900 Dance "Patriotic Night". Flags ordered. White Waistcoats
for Waiters requested.
- Apr. 1900 Madam Kaufman's "Calisthenic and Dancing Display".
