Many of our trees had started to shed their leaves early, a defence mechanism against lack of water. However, with the recent rains and now with a good drink the trees will start to show their lovely autumn colours and hold on to their leaves until the frosts arrive, resulting in a gorgeous display of colour throughout the arboretum.

It's not just the time for lovely leaf colour, as you walk around you will notice some beautiful fruits and berries on other trees.

The **Sorbus aucuparia 'Joseph Rock'** has a profusion of yellow berries and good leaf colour too. [pic right]



Another tree to watch out for is the **Metasequoia 'Matthaei Broom'** which is native to China. This cultivar has been taken from a witches broom. [pic left]

Planted in 2007 and doing extremely well, it's a slow growing dawn redwood with attractive lush sprays of soft green foliage turning to a rich orange/yellow display as autumn approaches.

We have also had some **major tree works** this year taking out 13 large conifers, which in itself was expensive. Now we have got to get rid of the stumps, another costly expense. [pic below]
