A good season, only in its third year and we're already enjoying spectacular blooms. It will eventually reach 25 feet with a similar spread.





Look out for our **Davidia involucrata** (pocket handkerchief) and see if you can spot how it got its common name!



We are very proud of our National **Taxodium** collection, which features at the start of the arboretum.



When in bloom, a curious fact is the needles stand upright and only droop later after 4-6 weeks.



Don't miss our **Azaleas** and **Rhododendrons** in full bloom on the main lawn.





Just before spring I took out the lower limbs (approx. 10 feet) on our **Metasequoia** glyetostroboides (Dawn redwood). In time $\sim around\ 10 - 20\ years \sim$ the nodules will twist and turn, toot and hoot creating an interesting trunk feature like those found in children's fairy tales.

Pay a visit to the top field to see our **Sequoiadendron giganteum** (Giant redwood) avenue planted to celebrate the 50 years of the Beale family at West Lodge Park.

The trees will grow around a foot a year and will ultimately reach over 130' high... but not in our lifetime!
