



Beale Arboretum Spring News ~ May 2019

The Beale Arboretum looks beautiful in its spring finery.

We have done lots of projects and plantings over the winter period, including the removal of most of the yuccas and cordelines from this bed to allow the Chusan palm and the Monkey Puzzle to flourish better. [pic right]



In addition we have planted over 80 new specimen trees, including those that form part of the **International Conifer Conservation Programme** run from Edinburgh Botanic Garden under the watchful eye of Martin Gardner MBE, and plenty more from the **National Pinetum at Bedgebury**, Kent, who's Director is Daniel Luscombe.



The Magnolia bed has also received a clear out this spring, to give more prominence to key varieties such as M. liliflora 'Nigra'. [pic left]



The **Mayflower or Cretaegus** collection has burst on or about May 1st, right on target this year. [pic right]



Ericaceous plants such as **Rhododendrons** and **Azaleas** are really struggling in the dry conditions we have experienced over the past few years at West Lodge Park, but the **Azaleas** have put on a good show this spring. [pic left]



An arboricultural oddity in the leguminous collection is the graft chimera between a laburnum and a broom - +Laburnocytisus 'Adamii' with both yellow and pink flowers. [pic left]

The growing Malus collection (crab apple) has been spectacular this season, a wonderful tree suitable for smaller gardens with great spring blossom and autumn fruits. [pic right]
