



Beale Arboretum Summer News ~ July 2017

Having enjoyed an early start to summer this year, the weather has changed becoming overcast and much wetter, which means our usual intensive watering of the big trees at this time of the year has not been necessary.



The rather under-rated **Fagus purpurea 'Pendula'** has lovely purple weeping branches that often reach the ground and start new roots.

The fruits of the **crab-apple** ripen fairly late in the season and are the size of a ping pong ball. The pink/red flesh has a

high pectin level, making the Harry Baker one of the best varieties for crab-apple jelly.



In its late summer/early autumn prime, the **Hibiscus syriacus 'Woodbridge'** displays a mass of mid-green foliage and an abundance of gorgeous deep pink flowers with beautifully contrasting crimson hearts that will keep on blooming until October!

A duplicate collection of **Catalpa** trees have been planted in the top field this year. The work is part of a scheme towards achieving National Collection status.

It's a new area - do take a walk and have a look.

The **old hedge line** has been removed that was originally planted to keep the sheep from the farmer's field out. This will be grassed over to create a new area for tree planting.





At this time of the year strolling along the path to Chestnut Lodge, you won't be able to avoid taking in the amazing sweet caramel scent of the **Japanese Judas tree**.

Keep an eye out for the lovely ripe edible figs at the biblical wall.
