



Beale Arboretum News ~ Winter 2015



Taxodium distichum

Following the St. Jude's storm damage to our **Taxodium distichum** (*seen in the background*), a replacement was planted in 2014. We are still undecided if the old one will be taken down.





Abies cephalonica, Abies A.forrestii, Abies squamata, Abies georgei

Take a look at the new winter planting of the four **Abies** (*conifer species*) in the main arboretum. When fully grown they should reach a height of 60 - 70 ft.









Part of our winter maintenance work is to **upgrade the pathways** - see the work in progress in its three stages above.

It's also a time for **clearing** (*pic left*). The copse at the bottom of the arboretum will be dug out to make way for future planting.



Hamamelis mollis (Witch hazel)

In addition to the winter flowers look out for the lovely corkscrew effect of the **Corylus**, which unusually is less attractive when in flower!



Sarcococca confusa

There's plenty of winter flowering to enjoy at this time of the year. Keep an eye out for the **Hamamelis mollis** at the bottom of the arboretum.



Corylus avellana 'Contorta' (Corkscrew hazel)

Just right of the large poplars, coming back up the arboretum, you may notice a lovely fragrance drifting in the air. This is from the honey-scented winter flowers of the **Sarcococca** (sweet box). It also creates a fountain of green all year.
